## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

- Keep the operating knob at 'OFF' position while lighting the burner, First open the regulating valve provided on the Cylinder, light the match stick or lighter over a burner top and then turn the knob in 'ON' position.
- 2. While putting off the Stove, first close the regulating valve of the Cylinder and then turn the Stove knob off.
- 3. Always keep the Cylinder in vertical position. Do not tilt or bend the Cylinder while in use.
- 4. Always remember that rubber tube should not have any bend or cut.
- 5. Do not attempt to dismantle or repair the stove yourself.
- 6. Avoid overflow of cooking stuff which not only put off the flame but may block the pores of the burner.
- 7. It is advisable to use original ISI marked rubber tube.
- 8. Always use genuine regulator having ISI mark.
- After the cooking is over always clean the stove properly and keep the pores of the burner open by cleaning it once in a week with a hole size needle.
